

LEROY VINNERGAR, known as - "The Walking Bass Man," among the musicians and the jazz buffs from coast to coast is another native son to win national acclaim in his respective field. He began his musical career right here, back in the 1940s, by wailing the 'up-right bass,' his current instrument.

During his early career, Leroy gigged at many of the noted Indy nite spots with the sensational Jimmy Coe and his small combo and other local aggregations. In the 1950s, my friend became a featured sideman with the late Art Tatum, internationally - known jazz pianist and his trio in Chicago, Ill. Later, Vinnergar went out on his own as a featured (single) Super-star bassist.

The known artists he has played with, run into the hundreds, and span many dif-ferent entertainment fields and styles. He's still the master of the four-to-the bar walking bass that soloists have come to depend on. Now, that Leroy is fronting his own all-star recording crew from the West Coast and currently on tour of the nation, he can embellish at will and show off his solo artistry as well as his writing and own contemporary sound. His line - up consist of Dwight Dickerson, pianist, Chuck Carter, drummer, Michel Barrere, guitar and Teddy Edwards, tenor-saxsman.






